This competition was a challenge to Schools in Britain to compete for the "Champion School Cup". Juniors, Children and Minis took part, and the points system ensured that they all competed against each other. The results of the Inter-School Competition were calculated from the individual results by awarding points for placings within category as follows: 1st 10 pts, 2nd 8 pts, 3rd 6 pts, 4th 4 pts, 5th 3 pts, 6th 2 pts, 7th 1 pt. The categories for which these points were awarded, for both Girls and Boys separately, were: Minis, Children I, Children II and Juniors.

Richmond, the British Champion School, was the school with the best total points score from a maximum of two racers counting per day and having at least two finishers per day regardless of how many of those finishers actually scored points in their age category.

^{*} Internationally based school were eligible to win an International Trophy if they finished ahead of all the British based schools. The races were run under British competition rules.
