Juniors, Children and Minis taking part and the results of the inter-school competition calculated from points awarded for Girls and Boys each day for placings within their age categories as follows: 1st 10 pts, 2nd 8 pts, 3rd 6 pts, 4th 4 pts, 5th 3 pts, 6th 2 pts, 7th 1 pt. The age categories: **Minis, Children I, Children II and Juniors.**

The British Champion School (High School of Dundee) scored **the highest points total from a maximum of two racers counting per day** and having at least two finishers per day regardless of how many of those finishers actually scored points in their age category.
