RACE INFORMATION

Registration and Seeding

The British Land National Children's Ski Championships are open to competitors in the following age categories

Children II	1995 -1996
Children I	1997 -1998

All British participants must be correctly registered with BASS through their Home Nation.

Eligibility

The British TD Forum and Alpine Executive have agreed to impose a maximum of 400 BASS points for Children as the acceptance criteria for the British Children's Championships. This has been the rule for some time but must now be enforced as numbers are growing.

Appeals to the Jury by foreign members of British clubs or by racers of British nationality who have trained outside the club or British system who are able to show race results, and by BASS registered competitors achieving the necessary points after the closing date, will be considered in the resort.

Race Entries

Where possible please *enter online*, using the Snowsport England Race Entry System: Click here; www.britski.org/online.htm and return your details, along with the correct remittance, before the closing date.

Postal Entries: please must complete page numbers 8, 9 and 11, and return, along with the correct remittance and before the closing date to: Ros Humphrey (Race Secretary) 8 Cambridge Way, Uckfield, East Sussex, TN22 2AD

Entries must be received no later than **Monday 22nd March 2010** otherwise a double entry fee will be applicable, and entry is not guaranteed.

NOTE: this is only a 5 week entry window.

NOTE: The online system will not collect additional data, such as your contact details in Meribel. Please complete a paper copy of page 9 entry form and bring to the race office on arrival in Meribel.

Acceptance

The Organising Committee will assess all entries and accept those from racers deemed to be of an appropriate standard. In the event of non-acceptance for any reason, the competitor has the right to appeal in writing to the Organising Committee, prior to the start of the competition. Should more than the maximum number of entries considered appropriate be received, racers will be accepted in seed point order. Every effort will be made to contact those who have not been accepted; however the organising committee accepts no responsibility in the event that contact cannot be made for any reason. A provisional list of British Entries will be posted on www.Britski.org by Monday 29th March 2010.

Late Entries

Late entries after Monday 22nd March 2010 within the qualifying standards will be accepted only in very exceptional circumstances and upon payment of double the entry fee. No guarantees can be made regarding the chances of a late acceptance and any hopeful competitor travelling to the resort before acceptance does so at his/her own risk of incurring any expense should he/she not be accepted for the Championships.

Entry Fees

Competitors must be aware that the Organising Committee incurs substantial financial liabilities in organising these events and entry fees are unlikely to be returned if the event is cancelled. The jury will consider possible refunds, or part refunds, if a competitor is ill / injured before the first team captain's meeting of the competition. No refunds will be made in resort. Such requests must be accompanied by a relevant medical certificate.

Club Team Competitions

For the Best Club and Best Named Club competitions, athletes may only compete for their first named club as published on the 4th BASS list 2010. Except in the most exceptional circumstances and with the prior approval of the Organizing Committee and clubs involved, no changes will be allowed in the resort.

Should athletes wish to compete for a different club from that shown on the current BASS list, they must notify their Home Nation in writing no later than Friday 6th March, so that the change can be incorporated in the 4th BASS list.

Equipment Regulations

Competitors and coaches are reminded that it is their responsibility to ensure that their equipment, including ski length and radius conforms to discipline specifications. The latest information can be found at www.britski.org/rules.htm

Helmets

It is mandatory for all competitors and forerunners in all disciplines to wear a crash helmet that conforms to the competition equipment specification. Helmets used in FIS Snowsports shall be specifically designed and manufactured for the particular discipline and shall bear a CE mark and conform to recognised and appropriate standards. Lift Passes

Free access to warm-up and race pistes for all competitors and bona fide coaching staff is included in the entry fee. Access will only be provided to racers on the start list on any given day. Coaches will be provided with a one week pass after the first team captain's meeting. To order lift passes, your team captain who will represent you at the team captain's meeting, must complete the lift pass form below and bring it to the resort for the first team captain's meeting. Meribel Valley lift passes will then be available to purchase from the Lift Pass Office on a daily basis for 13 Euros per day. If bookings for accommodation are made through Meribel Reservations a voucher will be supplied for a free weekly pass for the Meribel Valley Area.
