

ASC and BSA Grand Prix 2014 Programme

After the success of the series in 2013 the ASC returns to the Chamonix Valley with a schedule of four days of racing for Children U14/U16 who will have 2 x slalom and 2 x giant slalom, and three days of competition for the Bairns U10/U12 with a dual slalom, combi slalom, and a giant slalom with Parents Race for a Bairns/Parent team event. After the Bairns' GS the fastest twelve bairns and eight lassies (i.e. 12 boys and 8 girls age U12) will be invited to stay on for Tuesday's GS. Prizes will be awarded and medals to 5th place for girls and boys in all four age categories: U10, U12, U14 and U16.

Competition Notes

Race & Equipment Rules

These championships will be run under International Competition Rules (ICR) as amended by British rules (BCR) as of October 2013. It is the competitors and coaches responsibility to make sure that they are aware of these.

Equipment

Competitors and coaches are reminded that it is their responsibility to ensure that equipment, including ski length and radius, conforms to discipline specifications. Competitors and forerunners must wear approved crash helmets for all disciplines. U10/U12 racers will not be permitted to wear catsuits, except in Tuesday's GS when qualifiers may compete in catsuits *depending on a fair weather forecast* – a decision for Monday's team captains' meeting.

Eligibility

All U14 and U16 racers should be registered with the British Alpine Seeding System (BASS) for the 2013/14 season. We will be using the 2014-1 BASS seedlist which will be issued at the beginning of December 2013. **If you are not on this list you will be deemed to be unseeded** - so please check. The organising committee reserves the right to accept non registered racers at their discretion. Preference is likely to be given to BASS registered racers.

Competitors in the Bairns (Minis) categories must be registered with their Home Nation Governing Body or submit a signed *British Snowsports Athlete Declaration Form* (see above) **and** proof of public liability insurance, which includes cover for racing with the race entry. (Proof of membership of an HNGB affiliated club will cover this).

Photographs

Photographers may be present on the hill. If you object to photographs of yourself or child to be taken please inform the Chief of Race prior to the entry closing date.

Entries

Entries should be made on the entry form below and must be received, with payment, by the Championships Secretary by Friday 6th December 2013. Should the race be oversubscribed then entries will be taken on a **first come basis**. For fees, see above. Late entries may be considered but will incur an additional late entry fee of £10 per race.

Refunds

Once a race entry has been accepted, if the races are cancelled the organisers will endeavour to refund as much of the entry fee as they can, after covering fixed costs and expenses.

Acceptance and Bulletin

Acceptance lists will be posted on Britski shortly after the 6th December 2013. A race bulletin will also be emailed to entrants with a schedule for the managers' meetings and each day's racing in good time before the New Year.

Insurance

All competitors **MUST** have insurance cover for both ski racing **and** helicopter recovery.
