Race Bulletin No: 1 - Invitation



We invite registered racers to compete in the GBR Outdoor Event to be held at the Gloucester Ski Centre on 20 June 2015. This event is organised by Snowsport England. We would like to thank the management and staff of Gloucester Ski Centre and all volunteers for their assistance, without whom there would not be a race.

The GBR Race Series brings together national domestic races across the UK with race weekends being organised by the Home Nations in England, Scotland and Wales both on indoor and outdoor artificial slopes. For details on the GBR race weekends, events and race rules please visit www.britski.org

Entry Criteria and Acceptance

There will be 2 GBR races and each is open to racers registered with their respective home nation and meeting the age group categories eligible for oBARTS seeding for 2015 (born 2003 or earlier). The number of entrants is limited to a maximum of 180.

In the event of the race being oversubscribed, acceptance will be determined by seed points using the Outdoor BARTS list current as at the closing date for entries. (2015.2) Racers with lower seed points will be given preference.

There will be 2 GBR races for U10/U12.

The entry fee for this event is **£31.00 per day**. (To cover both GBR races). On line entry is available via the www.britski.org website.

The start order will be drawn at the Jury meeting using the SSE oBARTS Outdoor Seed List 2015.2 This seed list can be found on the web site www.gbski.com. The start lists will be published on www.britski.org and on the official notice board on the morning of the race.

Programme

GBR 2

The race will be run as a special slalom consisting of 2 runs down two different courses. The first run will be in reverse bib order. The second and final run will be in reverse time order based on the time from the first run and both must be completed.

For u10/u12 the format for the GBR 2 event will be 2 runs through a stubbies course, of which the fastest of the runs will count for prizes. This race is open to registered racers in the Under 10 category (YOB 2006-2007) and Under 12 (2004-2005)

GBR 3

This will be an individual dual slalom from which age group and overall GBR Series points will be decided, this event will be run after GBR 2 on Saturday. This event will be open to all age groups, there will be a female, male and U10/U12 event (through stubbies) and seeded from the times achieved in GBR 2. If a racer does not obtain a time from GBR 2 then they will still be included in the GBR 3 event but they will be drawn as the highest seeded skiers for the duals. This event will be a straight knockout event until the final, which will be best of 2, the further into the competition a racer gets the more points will be received.

To decide series points where racers get to the same stage before being knocked out, the racer that had the fastest time in the GBR 2 (The lowest dual seed) will be awarded the next highest point and so on until all points are allocated.

Race Rules / Health & Safety / Drug testing

The race will be run in accordance with FIS rules as varied by SSE and published in the BACR. Please see www.gbski.com for BACR rules.

During inspection racers need to wear or carry their bib so that it is visible. This is to show that you are entitled to be in the course area.

Inspection on foot by racers is not permissible

Helmets must be worn by racers/forerunners at all times whilst on the slope.

The U10 / U12 course will be run using stubbies and will not be seeded.

Please note coloured lubricant is NOT permitted on the slope

Gloves and long sleeved garments which also cover the midriff must be worn at all times whilst on the slope, including during open practice, course inspection and the race itself.

To comply with Health & Safety within Gloucester Ski Slope NO PERSONAL COOKING EQUIPMENT OR BBQs are permitted.

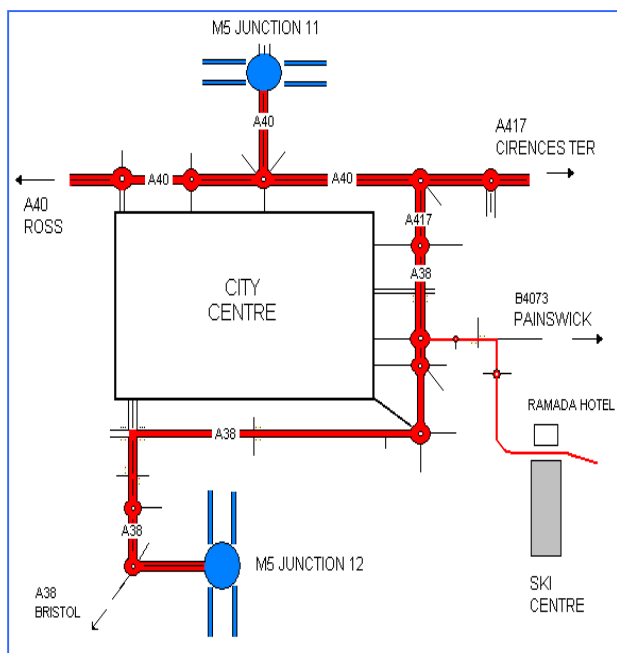
