ACCEPTANCE BULLETIN

The event is open to all regions recognised by Snowsport England and the home nations of Wales, Scotland, N.I. and Eire.

Each region may enter up to three teams and Wales, Scotland, Northern Ireland and Eire may enter up to two teams.

If the event is under subscribed then the Regions and Home Nations may enter additional teams subject to a maximum of 24.

Each team shall consist of seven racers two of which are to be the opposite gender to remainder of the team members.

All competitors must be a minimum of U14 and not more than three must be Seniors/Masters.

All competitors must be registered with their home nation governing body and compete only for the region to which their club is affiliated. Their club will be as stated on the latest BARTS list produced prior to the event.

Each team must provide one race official for the event.

The following entries have been provisionally accepted pending verification of team member eligibility after the publication of the o BARTS list 2015.02.

Race Bibs

Race bibs must be returned to the race office by Team Managers on completion of the event (please return bibs as a team). There will be a charge of £25 per bib for any bibs that are not returned.

Race Rules/Health and Safety

During inspection racers need to wear or carry their bib so that it is visible. This is to show that you are entitled to be in the course area.

Inspection on foot by racers is not permissible

Helmets must be worn by racers at all times whilst on the slope.

No aerosols are to be used in the start area

Gloves and long sleeved garments which also cover the midriff must be worn at all times whilst on the slope, including during open practice, course inspection and the race itself.

To comply with Health & Safety within Pendle Ski Slope NO PERSONAL COOKING EQUIPMENT OR BBQs are permitted.
