Acceptance

At the Jury meeting on Thursday 2nd July all 68 entries were accepted (42 male, 11 female, 6 U10/12 girls, 9 U10/12 boys).

Late Entries

The race will remain open until 1 pm on Friday 3rd July 2015 or until full via the online race entry system or by post/email to the race secretary. No late entry fee will be charged.

Protests and late entry acceptance confirmation

The Race Secretary must receive protests against non-acceptance of entries in writing by 10am on Friday 3rd July 2015. Results of protests and confirmation of acceptance of late entries may be obtained by phoning the race secretary, Tina Williams on 01275 891360 or 07794469048 between 4 and 6 pm on Friday 3rd July.

Refunds

Following entry to the race, racers who withdraw due to illness or injury will only be given a partial refund on production of a medical certificate. No other refunds will be given.

Race Office

The race office will be at the race secretary's address until the early evening of Friday 3rd July and will then be located at BASE CAMP, the Mendip Snowsport Centre, Lyncombe Drive, Churchill, Somerset, BS25 5PQ from 8am on Saturday 4th July 2015. Telephone contact can only be made by mobile after 6am on Saturday 4th July. Email contact will be subject to the availability of slope wifi and will not be before 8am on that date.

Start Order

The start order will be drawn at the Jury meeting on Thursday evening 2nd July 2015 using the oBARTS seed List 2015.3. This seed list is published at www.gbski.com/seedling.php. The start list will be published on www.britski.org, www.ersa.co.uk and on the official notice board on the morning of the race.

For the first run of the CN race the top 15 seeded competitors will be drawn, with competitors seeded 16th onwards running in seed point order. The highest bib number will run first. For the second run, the start order will be the same. For the Under 10s/Under 12s in the first run they will be randomly drawn, with the girls going first followed by the boys. For the second run, the start order will be the same. For the third run in both the CN and Under 10s/Under12s race, the start order will be reverse order of the best time from the first two runs, the slowest will run first.

For the U14 categories and above the race will run according to standard Club National format with three runs down the same course. Best time from Run 1 and Run 2 will determine the start position for Run 3 (in reverse order of the best time from the first 2 runs, the slowest to run first), and best time from run1/run 2 will be added to the time from Run 3 to determine final positions and seed points.

Race Rules/Health and Safety

- The race will be run under FIS rules as varied by SSE and published in the British Artificial Competition Rules (BACR). Please see www.gbski.com BACR Rules, and www.britski.org
- This race will be set as a Single-Pole-Slalom following the rule 801.2.6
- U10/U12 will be run through stubby gates with no seeding
- racers are advised to read the race manual available from www.gbski.com/www.britski.org
- **NB access to the slope is for racers, officials and accredited coaches only**
- gloves and long-sleeved garments that also cover the midriff must be worn at all times whilst on the slope, including open practice, course inspection and the race itself
- all competitors **MUST** wear a properly fitted and approved safety helmet on the slope throughout this event: this includes practice session, course inspection, forerunners and the race itself
- it should be noted that because of limited space ski prep is only permitted in the designated prep area which is signposted from the car park and **NOT** anywhere else
- to comply with Health and Safety within the slope **NO PERSONAL COOKING EQUIPMENT OR BBQs** will be allowed
- For safety reasons it will not be possible to access the slope from anywhere other than the formal slope entrance

During open practice bibs **MUST BE WORN** so number is visible from back and front. Racers without a bib will be asked to leave the slope. Racer assistants (e.g. coach or parent) will **NOT** be allowed onto the slope or in the Start Area because of the restricted size and the impact of overall numbers on the authorised capacity of the area.

Course Inspection

The course must be inspected wearing skis and bibs must be worn. No racer is allowed to ski the course during inspection. Course inspection may start at any point on the course and racers must come to a complete stop between each gate when inspecting the course.

Only Accredited Race Trainers/Coaches will be permitted to accompany their racers on the course during course inspection. Relevant accreditation will be issued by the Race Office on the day. This form is available for download from <http://www.britski.org/coaches2010.pdf>.

No other people will be allowed to enter the race area.

Referee's Report

Protocol will be announced and posted on the windows of the race office which will be in BASE CAMP (see signs at the slope) following completion of the first two runs for all age categories.

Protests against the Referees Report must be made on official forms, which will be available at the race office. These must be completed and handed in within the set time limit and accompanied by a fee of £25.00.

Commentator sheets and race bibs

Commentator sheets must be completed and handed in when collecting bibs. Race bibs must be returned to the finishmarshal on completion of the final run. Failure to do so will result in a charge of £25.00 for each missing bib.

Photography

Racers who do not wish to be photographed by any accredited photographer must notify the Race Secretary in writing by the end of race registration. Please email the Race Secretary at race.secretary@avonskiclub.co.uk if you do not wish to be photographed.

Directions:

The most straightforward approach is from the A38:

From the North: Travel past Bristol Airport, continue for several miles on the A38 to the village of Langford and pass a large garage/Budgeons on your right. At the traffic lights turn right and the ski centre is a couple of miles further along on the left.

From the South: On the A38 pass through the village of Sidcot with Sidcot School on your right and its' playing fields on your left. Continue to the traffic lights at Churchill with a fish bar on the right. At those traffic lights turn left and the ski centre is a couple of miles further along on the left.

From the West and the M5 exit at junction 21 and travel on the A270 to Congresbury where the main road makes a 90 degree bend at the MEZZE Hotel/restaurant. Take the right fork at the bend and continue straight for several miles, go right at the mini roundabout in Langford and skirt around Budgeons to join the A38 turn right and follow the directions for approaching from the North.
