We invite registered racers to compete in the GBR Indoor Event and Scottish Indoor Alpine Championships to be held at the Snow Factor on the weekend of Saturday 13th and Sunday 14th May 2015. This event weekend is organised by Snowsport Scotland. We would like to thank the management and staff of the Snow Factor and all volunteers for their assistance, without whom there would not be a race.

The GBR Race Series brings together national domestic races across the UK with race series events being organised by the Home Nations in England, Scotland and Wales both on indoor and outdoor artificial slopes. The Scottish Indoor Alpine Championships takes place annually at Snow Factor open to any BARTS registered racers.

Entry Criteria

Each race is open to racers registered with their respective home nation and within the age group categories eligible for iBARTS seeding for 2015, ie U14 category and older (born 2003 or earlier).

The number of entrants is limited to a maximum of 180. There is no minimum seedpoint entry cut-off.

Therefore, in the event of the race being oversubscribed, acceptance will be determined by seedpoints using the iBARTS list current as at the closing date for entries. **Racers with lower seedpoints will be given preference.**

There will also be an U10/12 race in both the GBR and Scottish Indoor Alpine Champs using stubbie gates. Competitors will have two runs with the fastest of the runs counting for prizes. This race is open to registered racers in the Under 10 category (YOB 2006 or younger) and Under 12 category (YOB 2005-2004)

Race Entry Information and Acceptance

The entry fee for this event is **£28.00 per day**. On line entry is available [here](#). All late entries accepted will be subject to an additional fee of **£10.00 per day**.

N.B As this race is expected to be over subscribed, there is no guarantee that any late entries will be accepted. It is strongly advised that entries are submitted by the closing date of **5th June 2015**.

Programme

Each race will be a special slalom consisting of 2 runs down two different courses. The times given below are provisional and may alter on the day, but in order to meet the tight timescales please ensure that you are ready to start on time and listen carefully for any announcements.

Every attempt will be made to keep to the event schedule; however the organisers reserve the right to amend the schedule as appropriate.

Open Practice on the recreational slope from 08.15 – 09.00 is included as part of the entry fee. Thereafter, if racers wish to ski on the non-race slope, they will have to pay at the standard rate available to the general public. Any racer who elects to ski on the non-race slope must bear in mind that the slope is open to the general public and extreme care will be needed. Snow Factor staff will remove anyone skiing in an inconsiderate manner and there will be no refund of unused fees.

Race Rules / Health & Safety / Drug testing

- Racer assistants (e.g. coach or parent) will not be allowed in the Start Area because of the restricted size of the start area and the impact of overall numbers on the authorised fire capacity of the arena.
- Ski preparation is not allowed anywhere inside the Snow Factor.
- Ski boots may be worn only between the Arena and Race Office area. Racers and officials who wish to go elsewhere in the centre must wear street footwear.
- Snow Factor will accept no responsibility for valuables left unattended.

Notes

- Inspection on foot by either racers or coaches is not permissible
- Racers will be advised of the method of inspection prior to the start of course inspection.

Awards

Awards for overall 1st, 2nd & 3rd Male & Female racers will be presented.

Withdrawals

Following entry into the race, a partial refund will only be given to racers on production of a medical certificate.
