**RULES**

The Championships will be run under FIS Rules as modified by Snowsport GB and Snowsport England, as published in the **British Artificial Competition Rules (BACR), 2015**. This manual is available on <http://www.gbski.com> .



Competitors are reminded of the regulations requiring the use of protective 'bungs' or caps on ski pole tips, and those governing the limits on ski/binding height. These regulations are liable to be enforced during this event.

Gloves and long sleeved garments which also cover the midriff must be worn at all times whilst on the slope, including during open practice, course inspection and the race itself.

Coloured lubricant is **NOT** permitted on the slope and spraying of aerosols is **NOT** permitted in the Start Area.

**All competitors MUST wear a properly fitted and approved safety helmet on the slope throughout the event; this includes practice session, course inspection, fore runners, and the race itself. Helmets- Racers are reminded of the new helmet rules, details of which can be found at:**

### TROPHIES

Perpetual trophies for English Champions will be presented again this year. **All trophies presented in 2015 must be returned in good condition and inscribed if appropriate by 10am on the morning of the Championships. If any athlete does not return such a trophy as indicated they will not be permitted to take part in the 2016 event.**

The winners of each trophy in 2016 will be asked to sign a form upon receipt ensuring the safekeeping of the trophy. These trophies must be returned prior to the next All England Championship in 2017. **Only racers registered with Snowsport England are eligible to win these trophies, they must also be registered as English or have been resident in England for at least nine out of the preceding twelve months.**

### REGISTRATION

Attention of racers is drawn to the fact that all acceptances are provisional on their registration as racers being valid before the competition.

**Start Licences may be inspected.**



## PROTESTS

For the individual championships, protests must be made on an Official Form, which will be available at the race office and accompanied with the fee of £25.00 (Refunded if successful)

**For the team championships, protests must be made immediately after the run, to a JURY member and accompanied with the fee of £25.00**

## PRIZE GIVING

This will take place on each day of the Championships at Gloucester Ski and Snowboard Centre. Snowsport England and the Race Organisers expect ALL prize winners to show due courtesy to the Sponsors and Race Organisers by being present at the appropriate Prize Giving Ceremony. Those who inexcusably do not attend may lose their claim to any Trophies / Prizes.

## ACCEPTANCE

A full acceptance list is attached to this bulletin. The Jury meeting considered all entries received by 5.30pm on Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> August 2016.

## WITHDRAWALS

Once accepted into the race the jury will consider a refund of £10.00 for withdrawals supported by Medical Evidence

## ALL ENGLAND INDIVIDUAL CHAMPIONSHIPS (Saturday)

126 Entries were received and considered for entry, 47 Females and 79 Males. All entries were accepted. A cut off point of 250 seed points had been set for acceptance into the championships, in accordance with Snowsport England Race Manual rule 826.5.

The top 15 seeded racers will be drawn on **Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> August** for start position and the remaining racers will race in descending seed point order for both Male and Female Competitions.

## UNDER 10/12's RACE (Saturday)

41 valid entries were considered and accepted (subject to receiving a coach's declaration), consisting of 19 Girls and 22 Boys. All racers will be drawn on **Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> AUGUST 2016** to determine the start order.

**A reminder to ALL U10/12s that their coach's signature form MUST be completed and handed in before a bib will be issued.**

**Any racer showing a D = Coach's signature required against their names on the Acceptance List, MUST complete the discrepancy BEFORE their bib will be issued.**

## LATE ENTRIES

LATE ENTRIES WILL BE CONSIDERED UNTIL 7pm WEDNESDAY 31<sup>st</sup> AUGUST on a first come first served basis **with no late entry fee**. After this date, late entries will be considered on payment of the late entry fee of £10.00, UNTIL A MAXIMUM OF 250 RACERS is reached or until 7pm Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> SEPTEMBER 2016.

## 2nd run for DSQ/DNF

The race organisers will attempt to give all racers, who are disqualified or did not finish the first run in the main event, a second descent. This will be outside of the competition and the jury reserve the right not to allow a second run to those competitors.

## SSE INTER CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS (Sunday)

13 Team Entries were received by the closing date and all were accepted, subject to valid club affiliation to Snowsport England.

As the race is undersubscribed at the original closing date, entries will be accepted by the Race Secretary until Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> September and entries accepted by Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> September will NOT be subject to an additional fee of £10.00.

Any LATE ENTRIES received after Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> September will be considered on a FIRST COME FIRST SERVED BASIS with the additional fee of £10.00. Further entries, up to a total of 32 teams will be considered until 10.00am on Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2016.

The following clubs have entered teams: Aldershot, Avon, Bromley, Chatham, Gloucester, Hemel, Midland, Pendle, Rossendale and Snowtrax

Racer substitution will be considered by the jury only in the case of "force majeure", that is injury or illness.

- Clubs will be randomly drawn and placed into leagues and will race against all other clubs in the same league. Winners and second placed clubs will go forward to the knockout stage of the competition.
- Teams having a bye in their first run will be allowed to ski the course.

The team must consist of 4 racers, minimum age category U14 and 1 racer must be of the opposite gender and not more than two of whom may be Seniors or Masters. Additionally, teams in the club competition must ensure that team members are registered as club members on the registration database.

All team members including reserves, must have the club they are racing for as their 1st named registered artificial ski club on the oBARTS seed list relevant at the time  
THE ABOVE RULES WILL BE ADHERED TO STRICTLY.

EACH TEAM ENTERED MUST PROVIDE A RACE OFFICIAL FOR THIS EVENT, names of nominees must be notified at the team managers' meeting on Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2016.



## **OPEN TEAM EVENT (Sunday)**

**Entries are now being taken for this event.** The maximum number of teams accepted will be 32.

**The closing time for entries into this event will be 12 noon on Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2016**

**Any racer wishing to take part in this event and cannot find a team to join, can contact the Race Secretary. Teams of 4 will be compiled from these requests.**

## **TEAM MANAGERS**

Team managers are reminded that the entry criteria states that ALL team members in these events must be registered as a racer with their Home Nation Governing Body.

## **RACE OFFICE**

The Race Office will be at the Race Secretary's address until the lunchtime of Friday 2nd September 2016 after which it will only be possible to make contact via mobile phone. It will be located in the Gloucester Ski and Snowboard Centre clubhouse from 8.00 a.m. on Race Day.

## **NOTICE BOARD**

The official notice board will be situated at Gloucester Ski and Snowboard Centre will be located near to the Race Office and clearly marked OFFICIAL RACE NOTICE BOARD.

## **RACE BIBS**

Race bibs must be returned, in the same condition, to the designated official after the second run. Failure to do so will result in a charge of £25.00.

## **FIRST AID & SAFETY**

Trained First Aid staff will be in attendance at the race and will be present on the slope at all times when racing is in progress.

## **OPEN PRACTICE**

There will an open practise session on Friday 2 September 2016 from 6 - 9pm, the cost set by Gloucester Ski and Snowboard Centre will be £10 for U16 and below and £15 for over 16.

## **PHOTOGRAPHY**

An accredited photographer is to be in place for the race. No other photographers will be permitted on the slope itself without prior approval by the organisers.

**Racers who wish to opt out of having their photographs taken by an accredited photographer must inform the Race Secretary prior to the day of the race.**

## **REFRESHMENTS/ENTERTAINMENT**

Drinks will be available for the bar.

### **FROM M5 JUNCTION 11**

Head for GLOUCESTER/CIRENCESTER on A40 dual carriageway  
At the first roundabout take the 2ND EXIT signposted CIRENCESTER A417  
Next roundabout take 3RD EXIT signposted GLOUCESTER A38  
At the next roundabout (Walls factory on your right) take the 2ND EXIT signposted GLOUCESTER A38.  
Continue through 3 sets of traffic lights  
Next roundabout take the 1ST EXIT signed PAINSWICK B4073.  
Through one set of traffic lights , after the PETROL STATION take the NEXT RIGHT signposted SKI CENTRE into MATSON LANE.  
50 metres to next roundabout, take the 2ND EXIT.  
You will see a SCHOOL, then a CHURCH. Shortly after a LEFT HAND BEND the SKI & SNOWBOARD CENTRE is on your RIGHT.

### **FROM A417 CIRENCESTER**

Follow the A417 underneath the M5 motorway. At the first roundabout ZOONS COURT ROUNDABOUT follow the A417 to GLOUCESTER.  
At the next roundabout (with the C&G building on your left) take 2ND EXIT signposted GLOUCESTER A38  
At the next roundabout (Walls factory on your right) take the 2ND EXIT signposted GLOUCESTER A38.

### **FROM M5 JUNCTION 12**

From the slip road (A38 exit of the M5) turn left (one way only)

At the 1st roundabout take the 2ND EXIT signed GLOUCESTER A38.

Follow the dual carriageway. At the next roundabout (Bumble Bee Pub on right) take the FIRST EXIT (straight ahead)

At the end of the dual carriageway are TRAFFIC LIGHTS. Move early into the right hand lane and TURN RIGHT signposted A38/A40.

Through one set of lights.

Next roundabout take the 2ND EXIT signposted CIRENCESTER A417/CHELTENHAM A40. (Church on your left)

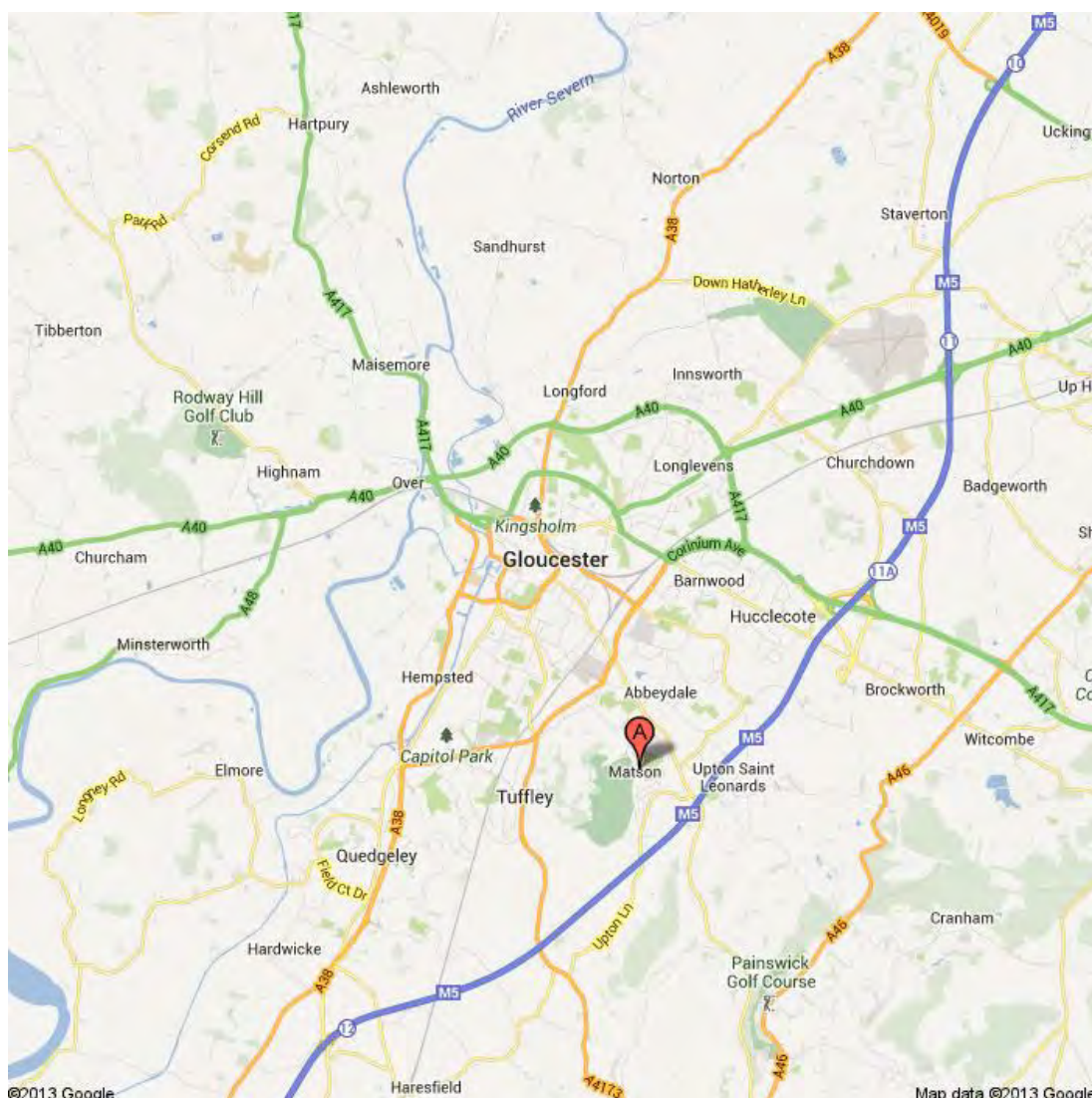
Next roundabout take 2ND EXIT signed CIRENCESTER/CHELTENHAM/M5.
