IMPORTANT:

THE RULES / REGULATIONS IMPLEMENTED BY CHILL FACTORE HAVE CHANGED FOR THE 2016 SEASON PARTICULARLY IN RELATION TO SKI/BOOTS NOT BEING ALLOWED UPSTAIRS UNLESS IN BAGS.

Race Bulletin No2 - Acceptance

Organisation

This event is being organised by Manchester Ski Racing.

Acceptance

Entry fee for this event is £29.00. Online entry is still available at <http://www.britski.org/online.htm> until 20th April 2016 at 6pm without incurring a late entry fee.

At the jury meeting 110 entries were accepted, 24 females, 44 males and 42 U10/U12

Entries from racers with a note by their name on the enclosed acceptance list were provisionally accepted, and must see the Race Secretary on race day to validate their entry prior to collecting their bib. Notes are as follows:

S requires the entry form to be signed.

P requires payment / payment adjustment of £29.00 race entry fee.

R requires proof of registration

C requires proof of competency

Late Entries

The online entry system will remain open until 6pm 20 April 2016 or until full. Non registered racers should contact the race secretary.

Protests and late entry acceptance confirmation

The Race Secretary must receive protests against non-acceptance of entries in writing/email. Results of protests may be obtained by phoning the Race Secretary Helen Potter on 07403 855 775 between 10am and 11am on Friday 22nd April.

Open Practice Friday 22 April 2016

There will be an open practice session on Friday 22 April 2016 from 5-7pm costing £29.00 for adults, £23.00 for children's/juniors. This includes the use of the course which will be laid out with carrots. Lift passes should be purchased from Chill Factor.

There is a private session 7pm-9pm which you can book onto through JR Ski Racing.

These costs are set by Chill Factor and Manchester Ski Racing has no influence over the cost and does not gain financially from this.

Any racer choosing to do this must bear in mind that the slope is open to the general public and extreme care will be needed. Chill Factor staff will remove anyone skiing in an inconsiderate manner.

Race Office

The race office will be at the race secretary's address until 4pm on Saturday 23rd April 2016 and will then be located in the **Aspen Suite** on the **first floor** at Chill Factor^e from 7.00 am on Sunday 24th April 2016.

The Chill Factor^e building will not be open until 7am on Sunday 24th April 2016.

Start Order

The start order will be drawn at the Jury meeting on Wednesday 20th April using the iBARTS Seed List (indoor slope races) relevant at the time of the draw. The seed lists are displayed on www.gbski.com. The start lists will be published on www.britski.org and on the official notice board on the morning of the race.

For the first run the top 15 seeded competitors will be drawn with competitors seeded 16th onwards running in seed point order. The second run will start on reverse order.

For the U10 / U12's in the first run, they will be randomly drawn with the girls going first followed by the boys. In the 2nd run the bib order will be reversed, girls going before the boys.

The U10 / U12 course will be run using stubbies and will not be seeded.

Regulations / Race Rules / Health & Safety:

The race will be run in accordance with FIS as varied by SSE and published in the British Artificial Competition Rules (BACR) dated Dec 2015.

All racers are advised to read the race manual available at: www.gbski.com or www.britski.org.

Helmets: Racers are reminded of the new helmet rules. Full details of the new requirements can be found at www.britski.org/rules.htm and following the link "UPDATED GUIDANCE ON HELMET REGULATIONS".

Slope Access

Access to the slope is for officials and racers only. Coaches may accompany their racers during course inspection only but must be on skis or blades.

Race trainers / coaches who accompany their racers must be qualified and carry the relevant accreditation issued by the race office on the day.

Open practice on Sunday 24th April 2016 is on the non-race side of the slope from 07.30 - 08.15 and is part of the entry fee. Thereafter any racer wishing to ski on the non-race slope will have to pay at the standard rate available to the general public. Any racer choosing to do this must bear in mind that the slope is open to the general public and extreme care will be needed.

During open practice bibs **MUST BE WORN** so that the number is visible from back and front. Racers without a bib will be asked to leave the slope.

Manchester Ski Racing cannot be held responsible for any competitor who does not abide by the Chill Factor[®] rules which results in the withdrawal of a competitor's lift pass for the entire slope due to any infringement of the Chill Factor[®] rules.

Chill Factor[®] staff will remove anyone skiing in an inconsiderate manner.

Course Inspection

The course must be inspected wearing skis and bibs with the number clearly visible. No racer is allowed to ski the course during inspection. Course inspection may start at any point on the course and racers must come to a complete stop between each gate when inspecting the course.

Race trainers/coaches may accompany their racers provided they are qualified and carry the relevant accreditation issued by the race office on the day or prior to the race.

No other people other than officials will be allowed to enter the race area.

Protocol / Referee's Report / Protest:

Protests against the Referee's Report must be made in writing on official forms, which will be available at the race office. These must be completed and handed in within the protest time following the publication of protocol, and accompanied by a fee of £25.00.

Refunds

Except as noted below, race entry fees are non-refundable.

Racers withdrawing on medical grounds may obtain a £10 refund of their entry fee if they apply to the Race Secretary and provide certified medical evidence to support their application.

Race Bibs

Race bibs must be returned to the Finish Marshall on completion of the final run. Failure to do so will result in a charge of £25.00 for each missing bib.

Photography

Racers who **do not wish to be photographed** by any accredited photographer must notify the Race Secretary in writing by the end of racer registration on the day of the race. Please email the Race Secretary at info@manchesterskiracing.co.uk if you do not wish to be photographed. Any parents wishing to take photographs **MUST** report to the race office prior to doing so.

First Aid:

First Aid cover will be available on the day by Chill Factor[®] slope staff. A medical assessment form will be on display on the official notice board.

Notice Board

The official race notice board will be located on the first floor outside the race office AND on the end wall of the changing cubicles in the racers area of the changing village.

Catering / Refreshments

Racers and families are reminded not to bring their own food in to Chill Factor[®].

Directions:

The Chill Factor[®] is situated next door to Manchester's Trafford Centre, just off junction 10 of the M60 motorway. Please see the map below.

For Sat Nav users the post code is M41 7JA. Some sat systems may not recognise the M41 postcode, which was introduced in 2008. If this postcode is not recognised, please enter the historical postcode: M17 8DD.



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Chill Factor[®] Race Event Procedures

CHANGING VILLAGE: Racers must only use the left hand side of the changing village. The benches on the right hand side of the changing village (airlock side) are assigned for other Chill Factor[®] guests. Racers can also wait snow side, or in the Sports bar upstairs.

BAGS: All racers bags must be stored in the lockers, training room, or bins provided on the left hand side of the changing village OR in the race office. Any bags left on or under benches in the changing village or blocking exits will be removed by Chill Factor[®] staff and placed in the dedicated storage spaces.

Once items of kit or clothing are wet, please refrain from carrying these into the Anton/Aspen conference suite and instead store these either in lockers on the ground floor or in the Training Room. £1.00 coin refundable lockers are available for smaller items of clothing or precious belongings in the Changing Village.

SKI BOOTS: NO Ski or Snowboard boots are allowed upstairs at any time. All racers must remove their boots before they go upstairs in Chill Factor and place them into a bag. Any skis/blades must also be placed into bags before going upstairs.

TICKETS: Chill Factor[®] will issue a race ticket through MSR to each competitor at bib issue. These tickets MUST be used to gain access to the slope through the airlock doors in the changing village AT ALL TIMES. Jumping over, climbing past or ducking under the turnstiles is not allowed under any circumstances. This ticket only gives you access to the slope to compete in the races. It does not qualify you to have practice time on the slope.

SKIS: Ski's must be stored in the ski racks provided by Chill Factor[®] at the bottom of the race side of the main slope. Skis must not at any time be left blocking any other snow side activity, entrance, and doorway or fire equipment. Access to skis store at the bottom of the slope will be for officials and racers wearing bibs only. Any skis left not in the racks or on the correct race side of the main slope will be removed by Chill Factor[®] staff.

BIBS: Race bibs issued to each racer must be worn at all times when in the changing village or snow side. They should be worn correctly and the number clearly visible to confirm your eligibility to be there.

Spectators and competitors when not competing can wait and view the race from the Sports Bar or the balcony.

Coaches who wish to accompany their racers for course inspection must obtain a lift pass from the race office, which should be used to access the slope through the air lock.

All of the food and drink outlets within Chill Factor[®] are franchised and not run by the Chill Factor[®]. Please do not consume your food and beverages within any of the tenants own cafes, restaurant seating areas or on the slope.

Ski preparation is not permitted anywhere within the Chill Factor[®] building.

Failure to comply could result in the Chill Factor[®] withdrawing your lift pass and/or excluding you from the building.
