## British Alpine Ski Competitions Guide to Helmets for Alpine Ski Racing Fifth Edition April 2016

### Announcement

**BCRs and BACRs follow current FIS Equipment Regulations.** All ROCs and participants in Alpine races (both snow and artificial surface) need to be aware that the BCRs and BACRs follow the FIS Equipment Regulations for Class A and B helmets.

**However, as a dispensation and transitional arrangement, for FIS level U14 and U16 events throughout the 2015/16 season GS and SG helmets meeting at least EN 1077 Class A and/or ASTM 2040, or higher standards (SNELL 98 or new FIS Standard), could be used.** The same dispensation applies to BASS and Artificial slope races for U14 and U16 for the 2016 Summer Season. The dispensation is also extended to U10 and U12 races. Current advice is that stocks of the conforming new helmets are freely available and that orders can be fulfilled in time for the 2016/17 Season.

**New Equipment rule 6.2.4:** The helmets shall be used without alteration/modification, as certified by the manufacturer. Furthermore, no additional element/equipment shall be affixed on the surface of the helmet. See explanatory notes below.

### Key Points

1. Helmets are compulsory for all British and FIS Alpine calendar events and in all disciplines.
2. Conformity to the rules may be checked at any event, and the lack of an approved helmet, or having a modified helmet, is grounds for refusal to allow a competitor to race.
3. Spoilers, visors or protruding edges are not permitted. Add-on items such as camera mounts stuck onto the surface of the helmet are not permitted. However, the application of other stickers is not contrary to the rule. Nevertheless, see note 4 below.
4. Any modification of a helmet, including the application of camera mounts, simple stickers or other decoration, may reduce the effectiveness of the helmet as the adhesives may weaken the shell material. Any such modification (unless carried out in the factory as part of the original manufacture) may also invalidate the helmet from the point of view of warranty and insurance cover. You are advised to follow the instructions given by the manufacturer in any literature accompanying the helmet when bought.
5. Hard shell must cover head and ears, except for slalom in which soft protection over the ears is allowed.

6. Must be labelled as meeting appropriate standards (EN 1077, CEE 1077, US 2040, or other standards as defined in FIS Equipment rules) and marked as intended for Alpine skiing. Conforming helmets for

7. A badly-fitting or over-large helmet may significantly reduce the level of protection provided, and may even add to the hazard or contribute to injury.
8. A helmet's level of protection will be significantly reduced if it is not fitted correctly; this includes the use of a beanie or head band worn under the helmet that may alter the fit of the helmet and therefore reduce its effectiveness.
9. A helmet is a vital piece of your competition equipment and should be properly looked after; dropping a helmet on a hard surface can significantly reduce the level of protection it would provide in the event of a fall.

## Chill Factor<sup>®</sup> Race Event Procedures

**CHANGING VILLAGE:** Racers must only use the left hand side of the changing village. The benches on the right hand side of the changing village (airlock side) are assigned for other Chill Factor<sup>®</sup> guests. Racers can also wait snow side, or in the Sports bar upstairs.

**BAGS:** All racers bags must be stored in the lockers, training room, or bins provided on the left hand side of the changing village OR in the race office. Any bags left on or under benches in the changing village or blocking exits will be removed by Chill Factor<sup>®</sup> staff and placed in the dedicated storage spaces.

Once items of kit or clothing are wet, please refrain from carrying these into the Anton/Aspen conference suite and instead store these either in lockers on the ground floor or in the Training Room. £1.00 coin refundable lockers are available for smaller items of clothing or precious belongings in the Changing Village.

**SKI BOOTS:** NO Ski or Snowboard boots are allowed upstairs at any time. All racers must remove their boots before they go upstairs in Chill Factor<sup>®</sup> and place them into a bag. Any skis/blades must also be placed into bags before going upstairs.

**TICKETS:** Chill Factor<sup>®</sup> will issue a race ticket through MSR to each competitor at bib issue. These tickets MUST be used to gain access to the slope through the airlock doors in the changing village AT ALL TIMES. Jumping over, climbing past or ducking under the turnstiles is not allowed under any circumstances. This ticket only gives you access to the slope to compete in the races. It does not qualify you to have practice time on the slope.

**SKIS:** Ski's must be stored in the ski racks provided by Chill Factor<sup>®</sup> at the bottom of the race side of the main slope. Skis must not at any time be left blocking any other snow side activity, entrance, and doorway or fire equipment. Access to skis store at the bottom of the slope will be for officials and racers wearing bibs only. Any skis left not in the racks or on the correct race side of the main slope will be removed by Chill Factor<sup>®</sup> staff.

**BIBS:** Race bibs issued to each racer must be worn at all times when in the changing village or snow side. They should be worn correctly and the number clearly visible to confirm your eligibility to be there.

Spectators and competitors when not competing can wait and view the race from the Sports Bar or the balcony.

Coaches who wish to accompany their racers for course inspection must obtain a lift pass from the race office, which should be used to access the slope through the air lock.

All of the food and drink outlets within Chill Factor<sup>®</sup> are franchised and not run by the Chill Factor<sup>®</sup>. Please do not consume your food and beverages within any of the tenants own cafes, restaurant seating areas or on the slope.

Ski preparation is not permitted anywhere within the Chill Factor<sup>®</sup> building.

Failure to comply could result in the Chill Factor<sup>®</sup> withdrawing your lift pass and/or excluding you from the building.
