Invitation Bulletin

We invite racers to compete in the above event to be held at the Pembrey Ski Centre on Saturday 16th and Sunday 17th April 2016. We hope all racers and spectators have an enjoyable day, and we would like to thank the management and staff of Pembrey Ski Centre and all volunteers for their assistance.

This event weekend is sponsored by the ski resort of Champéry Switzerland, venue for the Welsh Alpine Championships.

Format

Saturday 16th April 2016

In the morning there will be a 2 run seeded slalom, using two different courses.

In the afternoon we will hold a club team Parallel Slalom event. Teams should consist of 4 racers; at least one member should be of the opposite sex to the others and at least one member should be in the U10/U12/U14 category. Teams should consist of members from the same club, and clubs may enter as many teams as they wish to the team event. For clubs who struggle to meet the team requirements (ie where club skiers are left out after teams have been selected and entered), we will accept scratch teams submitted by affiliated clubs.

The team competition will commence with a league phase, so teams will get several races, the exact number will depend on the number of entries. Teams will be randomly drawn into leagues, and the top 2 teams from each league will progress to the knock out phase of the competition.

Sunday 17th April 2016

Excel Event - This event format includes 3 runs down one course with the fastest time to count, and is designed to serve the purpose of providing local development entry level race opportunities. The competition will be open to:

- Registered racers, who will be able to gain seeding from their participation
- U12/U10 (2008-2005) will be able to participate in these races but would not be eligible for seeding
- Non-registered 'day' entries (N.B. must be members of an affiliated ski club)

In accordance with the agreed seeding of artificial slope racing for 2016, competitors born 2004 and before will be eligible for seeding. Please note, this event is designed to give race experience and seeding to eligible competitors. At the Excel Event there will be no prizes or prize giving ceremony – it's all about skiing fast!

Excel Event Notes

1. Excel Events are organized to give developing racers increased opportunities to compete in entry level competitions. Entry priority will be given to registered racers with highest (most) seed points.
2. U12/10 race will be run using stubby poles.
3. Excel Events results will be sent to the national seeder to qualify for seeding. The event will be run under the supervision of an appointed British Technical Delegate.
4. No competitor with fewer than 40 BARTS points will be eligible to compete in Excel Events.
5. Every attempt will be to provide 3 timed runs during the race session. However, if due to circumstances beyond our control we are unable to complete 3 runs we will aim to seed the event based upon the fastest timed runs completed.
6. The 3 timed runs will run consecutively. Please be aware there will be little time for ski preparation between runs, if a racer misses their start they risk being sanctioned.
7. Referee's Report (disqualifications) for all runs will be posted at the end of the final timed run. Protests against disqualification will require a protest to be submitted with a protest fee of £25.00 within 15 minutes of the Report being published.
8. Race results will be posted at the end of racing on that day, they will also be published on the Snowsport Wales website www.snowsportwales.co.uk
9. There will be no prize giving ceremony, nor will there be medals or trophies awarded. Excel Events are organized to give race experience not prizes.

N.B. Any registered competitor who has points lower than 40 BARTS points is welcome to use the event as a training opportunity and will be allowed 3 timed runs with your times announced and recorded. We will run a group of such racers following each run as "Hors Concours" (honorary racers). You will not be eligible for seeding from the day. Your fees to participate for the day will be £15 per person. If you wish to participate and have points lower than 40 BARTS points, please email Chief of Race, Robin Kellen

Race Entry

The race is open to all age categories, and if under-subscribed, the race will also be open to unregistered racers on completion of the entry form at the end of this bulletin and payment of an additional fee of £5. U10/U12 & unregistered racers will not be eligible for seeding.

Registered racers are encouraged to enter through the online entry system via http://www.ersa.co.uk/national_races Entries will also be accepted by post. The entry fee for the individual events is £21 per race. Late entries may be accepted after the closing date, subject to an additional fee of £10. The closing date for entries (however they are submitted) is **7pm Friday 8th April 2016**.

Team entries should be made by post to the race secretary using the entry form at the end of this bulletin. The closing date for team entries is 7pm **Wednesday 13th April 2016**. The entry fee for the team event is £30 per team.

Withdrawals

Following entry into the race, a partial refund will only be given to racers with proof of injury or illness.
