RULES

BASS and unseeded races for U16, U14, U12 and U10 will be run under BCR (FIS ICR as amended by BSS).

Competitors are reminded to check the latest Equipment Rules. In particular, the wearing of competition suits ("cat suits") or similar one or multi piece clothing by U12 and U10s is prohibited (BCR 606.6) and all racers must wear a helmet suitable for Alpine ski racing.

PRIZES

Prizes* will be awarded as follows;

The following individual prizes will be awarded for male and female racers:

British Schools Alpine Champs (All races) – 1st, 2nd, 3rd – U10, U12, U14, U16.

The following 'Schools Team' prizes will be awarded in the Schools Champs races only (both races for U16 / U14 and the first race of each day for U12 / U10):

U16 / U14 (Male) School Team Winners (2x male from U16 & U14 category)
U16 / U14 (Female) School Team Winners (2x female from U16 & U14 category)
U16 / U14 (Mixed) School Team Winners (1x male, 1x female - U16 & U14 category)
U12 / U10 (Male) School Team Winners (2x male from U12 & U10 category)
U12 / U10 (Female) School Team Winners (2x female from U12 & U10 category)
U12 / U10 (Mixed) School Team Winners (1x male, 1x female – U12 & U10 category)

**Teams can include 2-4 skiers. Teams must nominate 1 category to compete within. The 2x 'best times' will count.*

***'Best times' = 2 fastest team members' combined times added together for U16/U14.*

****'Best times' = 2 fastest team members' single run times added together for U12/U10.*

****Team nominations can be made up to and including at the first team captains meeting on 11.4.17*

RACE ENTRY DETAILS

British competitors in age groups U14 and above must be registered with their respective Home Nation.

All competitors must have a current insurance policy that permits them to ski race. The Organising Committee may require proof of insurance such as a valid governing body race licence or an independent certificate of insurance.

Competitors in the U12 and U10 races must have either signed the British Athlete's Declaration or be registered with their Home Nation.

The Organising Committee reserves the right to refuse entry to skiers who do not possess seed points and who cannot demonstrate a minimum level of competence. Suitable evidence may include previous race results or certification from a coach.

All British entries must be made on the official entry form (one per competitor) or via the official online entry system on www.britski.org / www.ersa.co.uk Race entries will only be accepted if accompanied by the correct race entry fees:

£45 per competitor per event.

£80 per competitor for 2x events (U16 / U14).

£150 per competitor for 4x events (U12 / U10).

***School Teams must be nominated at the first team captains meeting; 11.4.2017.**

Any cheque payments must be made payable to "Snowsport England" and sent to the Championship Race Secretary.

An Entry List will be published on www.britski.org and will be updated approximately every two weeks up to 18th March 2017. (N.B. The Acceptance List will not then be updated with late entries).

THE CLOSING DATE IS MONDAY 10th APRIL 2017.

We urge all competitors to have their entries in with us before the closing date.

REFUNDS

In the case of withdrawal from any event due to injury (prior to the events) refunds will be available on production of a doctors' note / certificate.

Refunds will **not** be available for adverse weather or snow conditions that result in the cancellation of any races. The organisers & hill team will do their utmost to ensure that all of the races are run in full & on time.

VOLUNTEERS / SUPPORT

We will require a small amount of help from parents & supporters in resort during the races. The races are being run by a small team from Ambition Racing as well as some volunteers from the local ski club in Leogang. We will also have a small team of British officials in resort, including a TD, Chief of timing & Race Secretary to ensure the race meets the BCR standards for seeding. We may ask for help from coaches, teachers & parents at the first team meeting on 9th April 2017.

We will require volunteers on race days to fill a mix of roles including gate judging, bib collection, timing board etc. These positions need to be made up of volunteers from each club / school being represented. **We will ask for the names of the gate judges at the first race meeting, so please come prepared!** If you are available to help, you can also let us know in advanced of the championship to aide with our planning.

PHOTOGRAPHY

Official photographers may be present during the event. If you DO NOT wish for your photograph to be taken or used, please inform the race secretary in writing.

TRAVEL

Leogang is easily accessible via Munich Airport (2.5 hours), Innsbruck Airport (1.5 hours) or Salzburg Airport (1 hour). During the winter months, British Airways offer routes from both Gatwick & Heathrow with connections available for those flying from Edinburgh also. Ryanair will also operate a Glasgow – Salzburg direct flight during the winter months.

For access by car, the driving time is approximately 12 hours from Calais, with no mountain passes on route.

ACCOMMODATION

We are excited to announce that Mama Thresl Hotel will be our official Hotel partner for this event. All race meetings and award ceremonies will take place in their 'Think Tank' at this venue. The hotel is situated across the road from the base station of the Asitz (race piste) gondola. Packages for 5 nights B&B (9th – 14th) have been arranged at €370 for the first 2 people in a room and €245 for the 3rd and 4th persons in a room. FREE places are available for groups of 10 or more.
