Entry Form and Event Information

Welcome

We look forward to returning to Tignes, France again this year, with five days racing for the U16/U14 and U12/U10's. This year the programme has been stripped back to basics. There will be 1 Super G, 1 GS and 1 Slalom for the U16/U14 British Championships and 1 GS and 1 Combi for the U12/U10's. There will be a parallel slalom in the evening on Wednesday 5th April for teams of 4: 1 member from each of U16, U14, U12 and U10 including at least one member of the opposite gender. Please note, however, that the programme is provisional and dependent on local conditions – the current plan is that this will be run in Tignes La Lac.

We owe a big thank you to Jamie Ritblat and Delancey for once again sponsoring the Championships and special thanks must go to the Chairman of Delancey's Advisory Board, Sir John Ritblat. 2017 will be the 39th year that Sir John has been involved with sponsorship of the sport and without this support of the Championships and the team we would really struggle.

Tignes is a high altitude resort with extensive facilities. We are relieved that there will be no competition for these facilities from other British events in the resort this year, and we have every confidence that Tignes will provide the British Championships with excellent races.

Due to an increase in costs this year, unfortunately we have had to increase the entry fee to £50 per race. Arrangements are still being negotiated with the resort with regard to lift passes being supplied at a discounted rate. As soon as details are confirmed we will update this bulletin with lift pass pricing arrangements

Best wishes for a successful season and I look forward to seeing you all in Tignes.

RACE INFORMATION

Registration and Seeding

The British U16 and U14 Ski Championships and U12/U10 Race Events are open to competitors in the following age categories

U16	2001 – 2002
U14	2003 – 2004
U12	2005 – 2006
U10	2007 – 2008

All British participants for the U16/U14 races must be correctly registered with BASS through their Home Nation.

Eligibility

The British TD Forum and Alpine Executive have agreed to impose a maximum of 400 BASS points for Children as the acceptance criteria for the British U16 and U14 Championships, using the 2017.5 BASS list valid from 23rd March.

Appeals to the Jury by foreign members of British clubs or by racers of British nationality who have trained outside the club or British system who are able to show race results, will be considered in resort.

Entries must be received no later **than Saturday 18th March 2017** otherwise a double entry fee will be applicable, and entry is not guaranteed.

Acceptance

The Organising Committee will assess all entries and accept those from racers deemed to be of an appropriate standard. In the event of non-acceptance for any reason, the competitor has the right to appeal in writing to the Organising Committee, prior to the start of the competition. Should more than the maximum number of entries considered appropriate be received, racers will be accepted in seed point order. Every effort will be made to contact those who have not been accepted; however the Organising Committee accepts no responsibility in the event that contact cannot be made for any reason. A provisional list of British Entries will be posted on www.gbski.com by Monday 20th March 2017.

Late Entries

Late entries after Saturday 18th March 2017 within the qualifying standards will be accepted only in very exceptional circumstances and upon payment of double the entry fee. No guarantees can be made regarding the chances of a late acceptance and any hopeful competitor travelling to the resort before acceptance does so at his/her own risk of incurring any expense should he/she not be accepted for the Championships.

Entry Fees

Competitors must be aware that the Organising Committee incurs substantial financial liabilities in organising these events and entry fees are unlikely to be returned if the event is cancelled. The jury will consider possible refunds, or part refunds, if a competitor is ill / injured before the first team captains' meeting of the competition. No refunds will be made in resort. Such requests must be accompanied by a relevant medical certificate.

Club Team Competitions

For the Best Club and Best Named Club competitions, athletes may only compete for their first named club as published on BASS list2017.5. No changes will be allowed in the resort, except in the most exceptional circumstances and with the prior approval of the Organising Committee and clubs involved.

Parallel Slalom

The floodlit Parallel Slalom on Wednesday 5th April will be for teams of four with one racer from each category: U16, U14, U12 and U10. At least one member of the team must be of the opposite gender. Only athletes entered in at least two other events at the U16/U14 or one at the U12/U10 races will be eligible. There is no entry fee for the parallel slalom.

Equipment Regulations

Competitors and coaches are reminded that it is their responsibility to ensure that their equipment, including ski length and radius conforms to discipline specifications. 4. I undertake to be fully insured for racing (including accident, illness and third party cover), and will produce proof of such insurance to the Organising Committee, if required.
5. I will attend the prize giving and understand that I will relinquish any claims to prizes, trophies or any other benefits should I fail to do so.
6. I agree that if I am awarded a perpetual trophy, I will have it engraved, safeguard it and return it before the next Championships as requested by the Organising Committee.

8. I have signed a copy of the competitor's waiver (Athlete Declaration), and I have a valid BASS start number.
9. I understand that the entry fee is not refundable, even if one or more of the races are cancelled if the Organising Committee has incurred liabilities in setting up the Championships.
10. These Championships are run under BCR Rules, and these will apply at all times.
