

## SNOWSPORT ENGLAND SELECTION 2016 SUMMARY



### Time frames

As soon as the next BASS and FIS lists are published a selection meeting will take place attended by Jo Ryding, Tania Barton, Gillian Poth plus 1 independent person where we draft a list of all athletes meeting the criteria. All qualifying athletes will then receive an email via the email address listed with SSE for invitation to attend stage 2 and 3 on the 18/19<sup>th</sup> June. Within this email will be further details on the topics we will cover over the 3 weekends, costs etc

We aim to get these emails sent out by the 13<sup>th</sup> May.

Please ensure the email address you have registered with SSE is the correct one

Any athlete not receiving an email who feels they should have been selected has the right to appeal and all appeals should be sent to [Alpinesquad@snowsportengland.org.uk](mailto:Alpinesquad@snowsportengland.org.uk)

Stage 2 consists of a skills quest and stage 3 consists of an ACE fitness test

All athletes who successfully complete and pass both stages will then receive a letter via the post inviting them to join the squad. We aim to get these letters out within 3 weeks of the first squad weekend.

Athletes who have not passed stage 2 will have 1 further opportunity to complete this, athletes who have not passed stage 3 will have 2 further weekends in which to complete this element.

Athletes accepting must attend a minimum of 4 out of 6 squad days and have a programme consisting of a minimum of 10 weeks on snow.

English champs in Bormio - GS - Any athlete coming in the top 3 YOB English athletes in **combined** runs

British Champs in Tignes – GS - Any athlete coming in the top 3 YOB English athletes in **combined** runs

#### Athletes YOB 2003 – we will be looking at the following results:

Anglo Scottish Slalom Cup - Any athlete coming in the top 3 YOB English athletes in **combined** runs

Anglo Scottish GS Cup - Any athlete coming in the top 3 YOB English athletes in **combined** runs

Ambition races slalom - Any athlete coming in the top 3 YOB English athletes in **combined** runs

Ambition races GS - Any athlete coming in the top 3 YOB English athletes in **combined** runs

English champs in Bormio GS - Any athlete coming in the top 3 YOB English athletes in **combined** runs

English champs in Bormio Slalom - Any athlete coming in the top 3 YOB English athletes in **combined** runs

British Champs in Tignes slalom - Due to the fact this was only 1 run we will not be looking at this race

British Champs in Tignes GS on 31/03 - Any athlete coming in the top 3 YOB English athletes in **combined** runs

PLUS

Any athlete in the BASS list issued after the British Championships coming within 40 points of the best GBR racer in their YOB in slalom and GS combined i.e we take the points from slalom and the points from GS , add them together and divide them by 2

### **Athletes YOB 2002 – we will be looking at the following**

Any athlete in the BASS list issued after the British Championships coming within 40 points of the best **GBR** racer in their YOB in either slalom / GS or Super G e.g. If an athlete scores 200 points in slalom on the BASS list published after the British then every racer who has 240 points or below will qualify through to stage 2

Or

Top 8 **British** YOB in either Slalom , GS or Super G

### **Athletes YOB 2001 – we will be looking at the following**

Any athlete in the BASS list issued after the British Championships coming within 40 points of the best **GBR** racer in their YOB in either slalom / GS or Super G e.g. If an athlete scores 200 points in slalom on the BASS list published after the British then every racer who has 240 points or below will qualify through to stage 2

Or

Top 8 **British** YOB in either Slalom , GS or Super G

### **Athletes YOB 2000 – we will be looking at the following**

Any athlete in the BASS list issued after the British Championships coming within 40 points of the best **GBR** racer in their YOB in either slalom / GS or Super G e.g. If an athlete scores 200 points in slalom on the BASS list published after the British then every racer who has 240 points or below will qualify through to stage 2

Or

Top 8 **British** YOB in either Slalom , GS or Super G

### **Athletes YOB 1999 – we will be looking at the following**

FIS scores of 130 or below in Slalom, GS or Super G

Due to the fact that 2 successful Downhill races were run at Tignes we will now also be looking at Downhill scores

### **Athletes YOB 1998 – we will be looking at the following**

FIS scores of 115 or below in Slalom, GS or Super G

Due to the fact that 2 successful Downhill races were run at Tignes we will now also be looking at Downhill scores

### **Athletes YOB 1997 – we will be looking at the following**

FIS scores of 105 or below in Slalom, GS or Super G

Due to the fact that 2 successful Downhill races were run at Tignes we will now also be looking at Downhill scores

**Athletes YOB 1996 – we will be looking at the following**

FIS scores of 95 or below in Slalom, GS or Super G

Due to the fact that 2 successful Downhill races were run at Tignes we will now also be looking at Downhill scores
