GBR Indoor Series Awards

Since the publication of the 2015 artificial ski race calendar there has been considerable comment and disappointment expressed by the race community at the small number of races that make up the 2015 GBR Indoor series. This was due to the difficulty in agreeing suitable terms with certain indoor venues for 2015.

As a result, it is proposed that the Anglo Welsh and British Indoor events scheduled to take place in Manchester on Saturday 5th September and Sunday 6th September will count towards the overall GBR Indoor Series points for individual age categories and overall series awards, effectively as GBR Indoor races 4 and 5, making the GBR Indoor Series a 5 race series for 2015.

The GBR Indoor Series trophies and awards will be presented at this event.

GBR Outdoor Race 3

As many of you will be aware, a racer suffered a serious accident and injury whilst taking part in the GBR Outdoor race 3 event at Gloucester on Saturday 20th June. Due to the delay in getting the racer off the slope and based upon the advice received from the medical staff in attendance, the race organisers had to take the decision to abandon the event.

As a result, it has been decided that the £10 entry fee for GB Outdoor race 3 will be refunded to all entries in category U14 and above. Racers should have received refunds already. If not, then the refund will be made in the near future.

As the U10/U12 individual parallel event was completed, then series points will be awarded for these age categories for GBR Outdoor Race 3
