



## **Snowsport England Alpine Development Groups 2013/14**

Following announcements made by British Ski and Snowboard (BSS) that the U14 age group would become the responsibility of the home nations from 2013/14 Snowsport England has devised the following selection policy.

## **U14 Alpine Development Group**

- 1. Athletes must be registered with Snowsport England.
- 2. Athletes must have finished in the top 15 overall in their age category (U14) in one discipline (Giant Slalom or Slalom) at either the English Alpine Championships 2013 or the British Children's Championships 2013.
- 3. Athletes must have finished in the top 3 of the English athletes for their year of birth (YOB 2000) at the events mentioned in point 2.

Athletes born in 2001 and entering the U14 age category for the 2013/14 will have the opportunity to be nominated to the group following results at early season races.

## **U16 Alpine Development Group**

- 1. Athletes must be registered with Snowsport England
- 2. Athletes must have finished in the top 15 overall in the age category (U16 for 1998 YOB and U14 for 1999 YOB) at either the English Alpine Championships 2013 or the British Children's Championships 2013.
- 3. Athletes must have finished in the top 3 of the English athletes for their year of birth (YOB 1998) at the events mentioned in point 2. For YOB 1999, athletes must have finished in the top 3 of the English athletes for their YOB (1999) in the U14 age category at the events mentioned in point 2.

Any athlete on GB International duty is automatically selected.

In addition, athletes who <u>DID NOT</u> take part in <u>EITHER</u> the 2013 English Alpine Championships or the British Children's Championships 2013, may submit a coach recommendation to <u>i.findlay@snowsportengland.org.uk</u>
