## KIRSTEEN MCGIBBON AWARD

Since the tragic death of Kirsteen McGibbon in January 1996 a fund has been set up in her memory, thanks mostly to generous donations from all sides of British skiing. This is an annual award dedicated to the memory of Kirsteen.

## JOSHUA VARLEY SCHOLARSHIP

The Joshua Varley Scholarship is a scholarship to commemorate the life of Joshua, a keen skier, who tragically lost his life in a car crash at the young age of 17 years. The £1,000 scholarship will be awarded to the best overall English Junior at the Championships.

**CHAMPIONSHIP INFORMATION**

**REGISTRATION AND SEEDING**

The British Land Junior & Children Championships are open to competitors born in the following age categories: –

Jun 2	1987 -1989
Jun 1	1990 -1991
Chi 2	1992 -1993
Chi 1	1994 -1995

All British participants must be currently registered with BASS through their Home Nation.

Seeding will be based on FIS points for the Junior events. All Junior entrants must have a Full, Limited or Ghost FIS Licence. Any British Junior entrants who do not already have a current FIS Licence must apply at least three weeks prior to the Championships using the relevant form available on the SnowsportGB web site <http://www.snowsportgb.com/Forms>. Applications with the appropriate fee should be sent to the relevant Home Nation for endorsement

The British TD Forum and Alpine Executive have agreed to impose a maximum of 350 BASS points for Juniors and 400 BASS points for Children in any discipline as the acceptance criteria for the British Junior and Children's Championships. This has been the rule for some time but must now be enforced as numbers are growing.

Appeals to the Jury by foreign members of British clubs or by racers of British nationality who have trained outside the club or British system who are able to show race results, and by BASS registered competitors achieving the necessary points after the closing date, will be considered in the resort.

**FIS/Snowsport GB WAIVER**

All competitors must have signed the Snowsport GB Athlete Declaration. All competitors in FIS competition must also have signed the FIS Athlete Declaration. If you are correctly registered with your Home Nation and FIS, through Snowsport GB, you will have signed both of these.

**ENTRIES**

Non-British entries to the FIS events must be made by the appropriate National Federation on the FIS entry form at least one week prior to the start of competition and according to the Rules of the FIS Points 9.7 – International participation in National Championships.

## DEADLINES

All British entries must be received by Friday 16<sup>th</sup> March 2007. The appropriate entry fee must be enclosed with all entries. All cheques should be made payable to Snowsport GB.

## ACCEPTANCE

The Organising Committee will assess all entries and accept those from racers deemed to be of an appropriate standard. In the event of non-acceptance for any reason, the competitor has the right to appeal in writing to the Organising Committee prior to the start of the competition. Should more than the maximum number of entries considered appropriate be received, racers will be accepted in seed point order. Every effort will be made to contact those who have not been accepted, but Snowsport GB and the organisers accept no responsibility in the event that contact cannot be made for any reason. An acceptance list (subject to FIS regulations at the event) will be posted on the Snowsport GB website ([www.snowsportgb.com](http://www.snowsportgb.com)) within one week of the close of entries.

## LATE ENTRIES

Late entries within the qualifying standards will be accepted only in very exceptional circumstances upon payment of double the entry fee. No guarantees can be made regarding the chances of a late acceptance, and any hopeful competitors travelling to the resort before acceptance do so at their own risk of incurring any expense should they not be accepted for the Championships.

## ENTRY FEES

Competitors must be aware that Snowsport GB incurs substantial financial liabilities in putting on these events and entry fees are unlikely to be returned if the event is cancelled. The organiser will consider possible refunds, or part refunds, on production of a medical certificate, if a competitor is ill/injured before the competition. Entry fee includes uplift on race days.

## CLUB TEAM COMPETITIONS

For the Best Club and Best named Club competitions, athletes may only compete for their first named club as published on the 4<sup>th</sup> BASS list. Except in the most exceptional circumstances and with the prior approval of the organizing committee, no changes will be allowed in the resort.

Should athletes wish to compete for a different club from that shown on the current BASS list, they must notify their Home Nation in writing no later than Friday 9<sup>th</sup> March, so that the change can be incorporated in the 4<sup>th</sup> BASS list.

## HELMETS

All competitors and forerunners for ALL races and for training must wear approved Helmets.

## ANTI-DOPING REGULATIONS

All competitors must comply with FIS anti-doping regulations. Competitors using asthma inhalers should pay special attention to new regulations.

## CHILD WELFARE CO-ORDINATOR

Dr Jenny Shute has been appointed Child Welfare Co-ordinator for the British Junior and Children Championships.

## EQUIPMENT REGULATIONS

## RACE PROGRAMME

The Children's Slalom event will take place on the Mottaret race piste. All other events will be conducted on the Stade (subject to weather and local conditions at the time). The Children's Giant Slalom and Super G events will take place on the upper slopes of the Stade. The Race Organisation, in conjunction with the FIS TD or GB TD, reserves the right to rearrange the race programme if deemed necessary by weather or other local conditions.

## LIFT PASSES

Free access to warm-up and race pistes for all FIS/BASS competitors and bona fide coaching staff is included in the entry fee. Access will only be provided to racers on the start list on any given day.

Uplift to training pistes can be purchased both the week prior to competition and throughout the competition week from the lift pass station (counters 4 & 5) at the bottom of the competition piste. Uplift will be available to trainees at a cost of 12.00 Euros per day. Clubs are advised that these may only be purchased direct from the lift company and on a daily basis.

DECLARATION

To be signed by the racer (or parent/guardian if the racer is under 18 years of age\*)

1. I am eligible to enter these Championships
2. I fully understand that a high standard of behaviour is expected of all competitors on and off the snow. I agree to accept the ruling of the Organising Committee on all disciplinary matters to the extent that racers may be sent home, excluded from races or have prizes withheld in cases of a breach of discipline or unacceptable behaviour, and that in the case of such an occurrence no monies will be refunded.
3. I am medically fit to race.
4. I undertake to be fully insured for racing (including accident, illness and third party cover), and will produce proof of such insurance to the Organising Committee when so required.
5. I will attend the prizegiving and understand that I will relinquish any claims to prizes, trophies or any other benefits should I fail to do so.
6. I agree that if I am awarded a perpetual trophy, I will have it engraved, safeguard it and return it before the next Championships as requested by SnowsportGB
- 7.. I hereby free and relieve Snowsport GB, their Officers, Employees and Voluntary Assistants of any liability for injury, loss or damage of any kind incurred by me/my child whether due to gross negligence or otherwise.
8. I have signed a copy of the FIS competitors' waiver (Jun. only), and lodged it with Snowsport GB.
9. I will wear an approved crash helmet for all racing and training. I understand that I will have to satisfy the jury that I am competent to race in The British Championship Super G and, if I do not satisfy them, I will not be permitted to take part in the race. In this event, no monies will be refunded.
10. I understand that the entry fee is not refundable, even if one or more of the races are cancelled as Snowsport GB has incurred liabilities in setting up the Championships.
11. These Championships are run under FIS and British competition rules, and these will apply at all times.
